Joel D. Valdez Main Library Opportunity for Non-juried SACA Members December is a good month for SACA's non-juried members. They will have an opportunity to display their pottery at the Joel D. Valdez main library on Stone Avenue in downtown Tucson.

Pottery will be displayed in lighted glass cases in the lobby of the front entrance to the library.

- Open to SACA non-juried artists only
- Limited to 8 artists on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Each artist can have three to five pieces on display in the cases.
- Pieces can range from sculptural to functional.
- There is a limitation on the physical size; pottery cannot be larger than 12 inches in any dimension.

Everyone, please encourage your friends and students to apply. This is a great opportunity for some of our artists to gain experience with presenting pottery to the public. The show will begin on December 1 and remain until December 28.

We encourage SACA members to visit the library display in December to take a look at some of our newest and some not so new, members' work. On weekends there is free parking at the garage serving the library. The entrance to the garage is on Alameda Ave., just west of Stone Ave.

Registration is open now through November 20, 2021.

Tech Tip

Smart Phone Image Editors

Overall, I prefer using my desktop for photo editing, even though it takes extra steps to transfer files. However, when you must use your smartphone, nothing beats the default image editor.

For the intrepid few who would like to try something else, Snapseed and Image Size are two free image editors available for iOS and Android smartphones. Unfortunately, I have found the free apps usually do not include at least one of the functions we need in order to submit photos for calls to artists, exhibits or shows.

Editing Functions:

- Straightening Try using vertical and horizontal guidelines to rebalance tilts. Here is a great article from <u>photographylife</u>.
- Cropping Do this before resizing. If you crop an already resized image it may end up being too small and grainy.
- Resizing Stay as large and high resolution as possible. For SACA submissions, we post maximum image size (e.g. 1.4 MB,) and dimensions (usually at least 600 px but no more than 1800 px in any direction.)
- Renaming Create a meaningful descriptive name for each image. [e.g. Raku Vase - Mountainscape IV in White Crackle (10 in h x 7 in d).jpg]
 SACA accepts jpg, jpeg, gif, or png file extensions.
